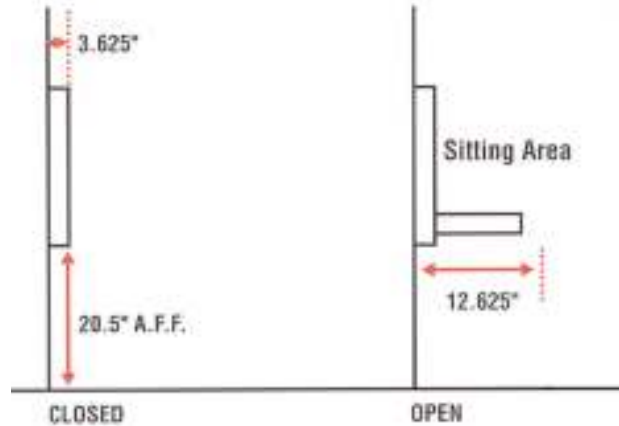

Baby Protection Seat
Surface Mounted – Columbia Guard (Antimicrobial Agent)



SPECIFICATIONS: Unit should be constructed from high density polyethylene which prohibits the retention of moisture and odors, reinforced steel rods to increase unit stability. Unit should be provided with the necessary hardware to install on most wall types and a self adhesive sign for installation on restroom door. Unit should be proven to withstand at least 150 lbs. of static weight. Unit shall be equipped with a genuine safety strap and the strap should be a three point harness for extra safety. Unit should have head and side support for added protection. Unit should contain a concave seating area to ensure child's comfort and protection. Unit should contain punch-out pre-drilled holes. The seat should be able to fold up for compact storage when not in use. Unit should be equipped with a molded-in diaper bag hook for customer convenience. Unit should be provided with a mounting template for easy installation. Unit is protected by **Columbia Guard**, an antimicrobial agent that is added to the processing. **Columbia Guard** protects against growth of microorganisms such as algae, bacteria, fungi and staph. Columbia Guard also reduces product deterioration due to premature degradation, odor, biofilm, discoloration and staining, it is non-migratory, inorganic (Silver), and is FDA and EPA registered.

OPERATION: Unit complies with ADA 4.27.4 Operation with One Hand or Closed Fist. Provide unit that is equipped with a safety belt.

INSTALLATION: Manufacturer will provide units with the necessary hardware to install on most wall types. Unit should protrude no more than 4" from the wall in it's closed position and less than 13" when fully open.. Unit should be adaptable to 16" stud wall construction with punch-out pre-drilled holes. Design should allow for easy passage around unit and contain no sharp corners to injure customers. Unit should comply with the following ADA Accessibility Guidelines when applicable and installed to the manufacturer's specifications: 4.4.1 Protruding Objects, 4.2.5 Forward Reach, 4.2.6 Side Reach, 4.23.3 and 4.23.7 Fixtures, 4.32.3 Knee Clearances at Counter and 4.32.4 Height of Counters.

The manufacturer reserves the right, without formal notification, to implement changes to the design and dimensions.
